Necessary attributes to stay connected in the spirit

Salm 103: "Bless the Lord oh my Soul" David realized the necessity to consciously speak to his Soul to bless the Lord and not to forget all His benefits

We are tripartite beings having our spirit which communicates with God and our soul (the realm of consciousness) resident in our body (identifier). We need to consciously address our souls like David, to create an attitude of heart to:

- > Bless the Lord.by praising Him in songs and/or prayers
- > Recount all the great deeds of God (psalm 136:1- end)
- > Not forget the benefits of Godliness especially when tempted to look back or discouraged

Psalm 63: 4-8 tells us that this attitude of heart when developed leads to satisfaction and a longing heart to fellowship more with God and His people, i.e., we as branches will stay connected and nourished by God (the Vine) to bear more fruit unto Godliness. We have all experienced our heart lifted up above despair and fear when we sing praises to the Lord. Praising Him leads us to praying more praise and joy in fellowship; we are satisfied in our spirit.

'Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.

My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips: When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches. Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice. My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.'

We experience peace that passes all understanding. Philippians 4:4-9 encourage us to:

- > Rejoice in the Lord
- > Lead a prayerful life
