

DEVOTIONAL MESSAGE

Glad Tidings from Heaven ... by Billy

READ LUKE 2:8-20

- The question often comes into our minds, why would the God of heaven send such glad tidings to such people on the margins of society?
- We heard last week about His choice of a young Jewish lady who exclaimed: "for He has regarded the lowly state of His handmaiden" (Luke 1:48)
- The immediate reaction of the shepherds is one of fear. (*Luke 2:9*). Perhaps they sensed that this was a day of judgment for their many sins.
- Such pure and radiant light shone around them that they must have felt so unclean by comparison.
- "And the angel said to them, fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy that will be for all the people." (v.10)
- There is this unchanging truth that has thrilled the hearts of millions down through the centuries. It is good news of a great joy.
- Let us once more be amazed as we contemplate this news and let it never become outdated to our ears.
- The scripture says that the humble will hear it and be glad. (*Psa.34:2*)
 - The shepherds entered into the joyful occasion and soon they would hurry to Bethlehem to see the sign which the angel foretold.
- First they were to see a sight of great heavenly jubilation as they beheld a multitude of the heavenly host of angels.
- Next, they were to hear the song of the angels.." Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased."
- How those dark and cold hills were transfigured that night and so it will be for those who are of a humble heart to receive God's message with gladness.
- Whilst most wondered at the words of the shepherds, Mary herself treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart.
- For many the gospel is a novel and curious report that perhaps holds some truth for the poor and the ignorant.
- For humble hearts the words of eternal life are deeply treasured and often pondered.
