



DEVOTIONAL MESSAGE

Read: Isaiah 42: 19, 18-25

- Who is blind, but my servant? or deaf, as my messenger that I sent? who is blind as he that is perfect, and blind as the LORD'S servant?

The Lord has been doing marvellous things amongst us lately and we as His people cannot afford not to recognise this time of visitation

- We need to be more awake with our spiritual eyes opened and to always have the realisation that the spiritual controls the physical.
- 1 Cor 2:11: For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- The testimony of our sister Modlin unearth a basic truth and how that we need to reexamine ourselves in order to live in the full realisation of Gods will in our lives. "The family gathered and prayed for cleansing" and the miracle of healing followed.
- Isaiah 42:24: Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law. We need the spirit of God to reveal the deep things for us to be free. -1 Cor 2:10.
- Blessed are your eyes for they see and your ears for the hear - Mat 13:16.

The Lord wants to do mighty works in our midst - 1 Cor 2:11, 9-16

- There is a danger in pulling back from joining others in the Lords battle and indulging in sin. 2 Sam 11:1-3: "But David tarried still at Jerusalem" and he got lured into sin with Bathsheba who is the grand daughter of Ahithophel. David killed Uriah.... But later repented and forgiven.
- Later, Absalom conspired with Ahithophel to kill David 2Sam16:23 but David prayed and the Lord turned the counsel of Ahithophel to foolishness by answering the prayer of David - 2 Sam15:31;16:23 ; 17:1,6,7,14,23, otherwise David would have been destroyed.
- Brethren! The spiritual controls the physical. We need to be wide awake now than ever before.
