# Exposing our Hearts ... by Billy

#### READ EZEKIEL 33:30-33

- oday we will heed the warning against living a shallow life. By shallow I mean trivial, superficial one dimensional.
- There is a shallowness in man that prevents him from exploring the deeper things of life even though he is made to do so.
- He is content with superficial elements that are more likely to satisfy his own immediate desires and also impress his fellow man such as image, financial worth and personality.
- When a man sits and listens to the word of God he may even congratulate himself that he is better than most because he can enjoy a good sermon.
- In this passage we have a picture of such a company of people.
- There are seen to encourage one another to go and listen to God's word which is in itself a very good thing.
- So they are sitting and listening although their hearts are still set on lust and greed. How can this be? (Isaiah 58).
- It is because they have reserved the deeper level of heart affection for selfish passions and desires.
- I think that when God seeks to enter into the affairs of people He finds many 'reserved' signs in each room of the life.
- God's searching word is kept at arm's length.
- Do we really want to spend our time rating the preachers or debating the controversial verses? This is a sign of shallowness.
- It is tragic to witness the destruction that people bring upon themselves because they refuse to obey the command of Jesus Christ.
- The greatest ruin of all is that they have separated themselves from Christ for eternity in a place of torment.
- The priority for them is for more leisure, more profit and more fame but true followers of Jesus Christ must refuse to put such things in front of obedience to the word of God.
- We need to learn to listen in a way that exposes our hearts to the searching words of scripture.
