- Everyone is under the shadow of the cross. For the unbeliever it is a threatening, gloomy darkness. Even Jesus came under its shadow in Gethsemane. In His anguish He sweat drops of blood. When He hung on the cross, there was darkness over the land for three hours. Peter's preaching of the cross at Pentecost brought 3,000 men under its shadow, and ultimately to salvation. Believers have stepped through the shadow of the cross to the light of the resurrection. We must walk in the light, bringing every other shadow to the foot of the cross. We must not allow anything to block God's light if we are to be effective in this world.
