Know Your Enemy (Part 2) ... by Nora

- In part one we looked at:

The enemy's strategy: To destroy God's masterpiece – mankind ; *John 10:10*

The enemy's nature: Liar, Murderer, Accuser, Slanderer; *John 8:44*

The enemy's tactics:

- To use our innate pride against us. Jealousy/selfish ambition
- Accusations/slander/lies.

- We continue with another of his tactics which we will see in *Matthew 13:24-30, 37-43*. Satan has 2 objectives in planting these 'weeds.'

To prevent people coming to Christ. Substituting another gospel.

To confuse and discourage believers and to make them ineffective.

- Most commentators believe that the weed referred to in the passage is darnel. Darnel is known as wheat's evil twin. Its official name comes from a Latin word for "drunk".

- **Properties of Darnel:**

It is poisonous. In small doses, it gives bread/beer a special kick. It makes one dizzy, off-balance and nauseous.

It messes with a person's vision and speech. It has mind-altering properties.

It is a mimic plant. Appears to be genuine wheat until the head forms. At this point it is obvious as the head is infected with mould and becomes poisonous.

These people will closely resemble real believers. They talk the talk so to speak. They might be very religious. They can be very nice, kind people.

The New Testament talks about false prophets, messiahs, teachers, arguments, apostles and believers. They have one thing in common. They all seem at first to be genuine.

- In the parable, the weeds remained unnoticed until they began to produce grain. What are we to do about the weeds?

We must be alert and keep our eyes open. If the workers in the story failed to spot the darnel among the wheat the entire crop would have been contaminated.

The disciples went to Jesus to understand the parable. We must get to know the truth. Both the Person and the Word.

We must be patient. Wait on God's timing. (e.g. Saul) We judge the teaching not the teachers. God may yet bring these people into His Kingdom. Jesus alone is the Judge.

There is a judgement day.

Those still not trusting in Jesus alone for salvation will find themselves, as the weeds in the parable, heading for the furnace. Today is the day of salvation. Make sure you are among the wheat which will be taken into the Master's barn. ■
