READ 1 COR. 2: 6-13

- Notice that Paul in writing to the church at Corinth quotes from this verse in *Isaiah 64:4* and in doing so reminds them that nothing has changed as far as God's promise is concerned.
- Israel's experience of God's deliverance during the Exodus was the foundation of their hope for a fresh deliverance from captivity.
- No one could have imagined that divine rescue plan. They were pursued by Pharaoh's army on one side and barricaded by the Red Sea on the other side.
- The context of the *1 Cor. 2* passage has to do with the hidden wisdom of God revealed in the cross of Christ.
- The cross of Christ brings to mankind the ultimate deliverance from sin, the power of Satan, death and hell.
- The cross of our Saviour brings to us a greater freedom than that experienced both in the Exodus and the Captivity.
- The truth is that no human being has ever imagined, heard in any discussion or seen in any vision what God has prepared for those who love him.
- So God wants to do unthinkable and unimaginable things for those who wait upon His promise. God by His Spirit reveals such unthinkable and unimaginable things to our human spirit as we humble our hearts in His presence.
- It is only to those that love Him that such things are revealed- those who value and esteem Him, are faithful towards Him and who delight in Him.
- Such wisdom is plainly signified and distinctly declared to those who seek God with all their heart and with all their soul and strength.
