Ready For Battle by Gareth

- he apostle Paul was encouraging Timothy to be a good soldier but in doing so he would encounter hardship, be engaged in warfare and was not to be entangled in the affairs of this life.
- As many already know we have been called into battle, not a physical battle but a spiritual one; Eph 6 v 12 - this is a battle that we need to be ready for.
- To be ready for the battle you need To know the commander. To be ready we need to obey the commander. Our commander is the Lord Jesus Christ. Even if the command sometimes doesn't make sense to you. Think of the disciples when out fishing all night; Luke 5 vs 4 6 "Nevertheless at thy Word".
- To be ready for battle we need to know our weapons, we need to be using them. So what weapons do we have in this spiritual battle?
- The Word of God. Jesus used the Word of God when in battle with Satan. Matt 4 vs 1-11.
- The Word of God is sharper than any double edged sword; *Heb 4 v 12*.
- The weapon of prayer. Knowing about prayer and its power is not the same as praying and experiencing that power that only true prayer brings.
- Knowing the enemies tatics. Paul had experienced many of the enemies plots to kill him; Acts 9 vs 23-24: Acts 23 vs 12-13.
- Let's not be lured into a sense of false security by the enemy of our souls, as Eve was in the garden of Eden; Gen 3 v 1.
- As believers we will encounter hardship, many of our brothers and sisters in Christ in places like Nigeria are enduring much hardship at this time. No soldier in the spiritual battle can down weapons, take off their uniform and put on the off duty clothing. The battle is continual, but praise God the victory has been won. All because of the cross of Christ.
